



Furnaze Saves OH Both "Oll" and "Oll Vapor" are thrown out of the oil inlet on the average Model A motor. Funiage condenses this vapor and returns it to the crank case together with the solid oil which it traps and doesn't permit to escape.

Furnisze Eliminates the Mess. Ordinarily the oil and vapor thrown out of the oil inlet are condensed in the grown of the regular filler cap. This off and vapor forms in drops which hang on the edge of cap until they either drop off or are blown off by the fan draft! In either case these drops of oil cause a mess to accumulate on the side of the motor, steering column; and cowl. Furnage eliminates this mess.

Fumaze Gives Crank Case Proper Ventitation. The crank case of any motor and particularly the type of motor in Model A must have adequate ventilation. The placing of screens, baffles or other obstructions in the filler cap will of course stop the oil if enough of

them are used. This same result could be obtained with a wooden plug or corn cob. But, if full 100 \$ ventilation is interfered with, the pressure resulting in the crank case will force the rear main bearing gasket to give way and the oil will all be lost into the transmission. Many a motor has been rained by the use of cheap attachments. Furneze has no screens, ballies or other obstructions. The bowl with the hinge lid is a condensing chamber. The principle is right and it functions 100% right, allowing full unobstructed ventilation.

Fumsze Side Tracks the Disagreeable Fumes. The fames which are ordinarily released on the direct draft of the fan and are consequently blown through every crevice into the closed car, causes much discomfort to the occupants. Fuenaze carries these fames down to the rear of the pan, away from the fan draft where they are carried away by the natural draft under the body.
