
A battery can leak acid for months before you notice it. During this time, the acid will attack any metal surface it encounters. Rust will form and it will spread and begin to destroy your car.

The **Battery Mat** is made of super absorbent polypropylene needlepunch felt, a rugged space age product.

Its unique construction allows the *Battery Mat* to trap and contain acid while its powerful neutralizing agents start to work immediately to counterbalance the hazardous effects of the acid.

The **Battery Mat** can be installed on all foreign and domestic cars, vans, minivans and trucks. The **Battery Mat** is also suitable for agricultural equipment and marine and industrial applications.



INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

- To enhance your Battery Mat's potential for absorbing acid, it should be cut to a size that will provide a skirt area of approximately 1/8 inch on each side of your battery. To determine the proper size for your Battery Mat, measure the length and width of your battery and add 1/4 inch to the length and width figures. For example, assume your battery is 6 1/4 inches wide and 10 1/4 inches long. Adding 1/4 inch to each measurement will yield the new figures of 6 1/2 inches in width and 10 1/2 inches in length.
- Using a pair of scissors, cut the Battery Mat to the dimensions you determined in Step 1. Discard the leftover portion of the Battery Mat in a trash receptacle.
- Unbolt and remove the battery's "hold-down clamp." The hold-down clamp might be on the top side of the battery or it may be located at the base of the battery.
- With the clamp removed, raise the battery enough to place the Battery Mat directly under your battery. For best results, place the printed side down. The Battery Mat will now be "sandwiched" between the battery and the battery mount.
- After making certain that the battery is replaced in its proper location, reposition and secure the battery clamp.

CAUTION I—Lead acid batteries produce explosive gases. Keep sparks, flames and lighted agarettes away from batteries. Remember that most batteries contain sulfuric acid—wear safety goggles. In case of contact with skin, eyes or clothing, flush immediately with large amounts of water. The Battery Mat is said as a preventaine product. No guarantee/warranty expressed or implied.
